9	On or about March 21, 2001, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission
10	(Commission) received a report from Lavonne Bush, Superintendent, Neah-Kah-Nie School
11	District indicating that Elizabeth Gienger, a licensed educator, participated in receiving and
12	sending emails over the District email system which were both inappropriate and potentially
13	hurtful to other staff members.
14	Ms. Gienger fully cooperated with the Commission's investigation and did not contest the
15	allegations. After review of the matters alleged, Ms. Gienger and the Commission agree that
16	their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to
17	certain facts, a public reprimand and a one (1) year period of probation. Ms. Gienger
18	understands that the probation will be subject to specific conditions. This Order sets forth the
19	facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. In entering into this
20	stipulation, Ms. Gienger waives the right to a hearing to contest the finding of fact, conclusion of
21	law and order set forth below.
22	STIPULATION OF FACTS
23	1. Ms. Gienger holds a Standard Teaching License valid December 26, 1996 through
24	December 31, 2001. Ms. Gienger has been continually licensed by the Commission since July
25	26, 1984. There are no prior complaints on file.
26	2. Ms. Gienger is employed by Neah-Kah-Nie School District. She began her
27	employment with the District as a licensed educator since September of 1984.
