6	On October 12, 2004, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission)
7	received information in the form of a newspaper article published in the Oregonian indicating
8	that Roger L. Woehl (Woehl) may have violated Standards by using public office for the financial
9	gain of a relative.
10	Mr. Woehl fully cooperated with the Commission's investigation. After review of the
11	matters alleged, Mr. Woehl and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together
12	with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and an imposition of a
13	Public Reprimand.
14	This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to
15	be imposed. Mr. Woehl stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's
16	files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth below. In
17	entering into this stipulation, Mr. Woehl waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of
18	fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.
19	This stipulation is contingent upon approval and adoption of the Order by the
20	Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this Order, neither Mr. Woehl nor the
21	Commission are bound by these stipulations, and Mr. Woehl retains all rights to a hearing on
22	the allegations.
23	STIPULATION OF FACTS
24	1. Mr. Woehl has been licensed by the Commission since June 1, 1993. Mr. Woehl
25	currently holds a Standard Administrative License issued October 22, 2002, valid until
26	October 6, 2007, with a Standard Superintendent Endorsement.

1	2. Mr. Woehl is serving as the Superintendent of West Linn/Wilsonville School District
2	and has been since 1993.
3	3. On July 23, 2003, Mr. Woehl, serving as Superintendent of West Linn/Wilsonville
4	School District, entered the school district into a contract to pay for the personal services of his
5	stepson, Lee Butler, to design a website for the District. Mr. Woehl did not notify his appointing
6	authority (the West Linn/Wilsonville School Board) of the nature of the actual conflict of interest
7	that arose in relation to contracting with his stepson and did not ask that the appointing authority
8	dispose of the matter.

17	In hiring his stepson to provide personal services on contract to the West
18	Linn/Wilsonville School District and failing to disclose this conflict of interest to the West
19	Linn/Wilsonville School Board Mr. Woehl failed to demonstrate a commitment to use
20	professional judgment in this matter. His failure constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of
21	OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5). The Commission's authority
22	to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.
