



1 a. On or about December 1, 2016, Demeaux entered into an employment  
2 contract with SSD, accepting his probationary teaching contract for the  
3 2017-2018 school year. On October 4, 2017, Demeaux submitted his  
4 resignation to SSD, effective October 12, 2017. Demeaux was advised of  
5 the requirement to provide 60 days' notice as detailed in state law.  
6 Demeaux failed to provide the required notice.

7 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

8 Gregory J Demeaux's conduct, as described above, constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty  
9 in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-  
10 020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (*Using district lawful*  
11 *and reasonable rules and regulations*); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(j) (*Resignation from a*  
12 *contract in violation of ORS 342.553*).

14 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS  
15 342.175.

16 **FINAL ORDER**

17 The Commission hereby issues a Public Reprimand upon Gregory J Demeaux's  
18 Educator licensure.
