5	discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.120 through 342.430 and OAR Chapter 584.	
6	FINAL ORDER	
7	The Commission hereby adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and	
8	conclusions of law and hereby imposes a Public Reprimand on James Martin Houston. This	
9	Order shall serve as the Public Reprimand.
