7	On October 19, 2015, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission
8	(Commission) received a report from the Morrow County School District alleging
9	professional misconduct on the part of licensed educator, Neil John Livingston
10	(Livingston).
11	After review of the matters alleged, Livingston and the Commission agree that
12	their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a
13	stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a public reprimand.
14	By signing below, Livingston acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees
15	to the following: (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to
16	contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and
17	finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this
18	Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii)
19	this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon
20	request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and
21	subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not
22	approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Livingston nor the
23	Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and
24	Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or
25	duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of
26	the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promise or representation has
27	been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has
28	consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully
29	advised with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an
30	attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of
31	the Stipulated Final Order below.

33	STIPULATION OF FACTS
34	1. Neil John Livingston has been licensed by the Commission since October 21, 2008.
35	Livingston's Substitute Teaching License, with an endorsement in Substitute Any
36	Specialty (PP-12), was valid from April 22, 2010, through April 21, 2013. Livingston did

1	not make application for renewal. During all relevant times, Livingston was employed by
2	the Morrow County School District as a contracted football coach.
3	2. On October 19, 2015, the Commission received a report from the Morrow County School
4	District of possible misconduct by Livingston. Investigation determined that on October
5	12, 2015, while coaching football practice, after you stopped a player from possibly
6	running into you while running a play, you engaged in a physical and verbal altercation
7	with the student athlete. The Morrow County School District placed you on
8	administrative leave for the remainder of the football season, but you resigned your
9	coaching position on October 22, 2015. Local law enforcement investigated the incident
10	and elected not to file any charges, citing in part, that the involved student's family did
11	not wish to press charges.

21	CONCLUSION OF LAW
22	Neil John Livingston's conduct as described above, violates professional
23	standards. Livingston's conduct constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS
24	342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(1)
25	(Recognize the worth and dignity of all persons and respect for each individual), OAR
26	584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(d)
27	(Unreasonable physical force against students, fellow employees, or visitors to the
28	school, except as permitted under ORS 339.250).
29	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
30	ORS 342.175.

1	ORDER
2	Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby orders as follows:
3	1. The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
4	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a Public Reprimand on Neil
5	John Livingston's educator license(s).
