26	Whitr	ney did not request a hearing. The Commission, therefore, finds Whitney to be in
27	defau	lt and enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and final order, based
28	on the	e files and records of the Commission concerning this matter.
29		FINDINGS OF FACT
30	1.	Whitney has been licensed by the Commission since August 17, 2015. Whitney
31		previously held a Restricted School Counselor License, with an endorsement in
32		School Counselor (PK-12), valid from July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017.
33		During all relevant times, Whitney was employed by the Portland Public School
34		District (PPSD).
35	2.	On December 21, 2016, the Commission was notified by the PPSD that Whitney
36		may have violated professional standards by failing to provide 60 day notice of
37		resignation as required by contract and state law ORS 342.553(1). Subsequent

investigation determined the following:

2 a. On July 12, 2015, Whitney signed a First Year Probationary Contract with 3 PPS, and in doing so, accepted the school counselor contract for the 2015-2016 school year. This contract was renewed for the following 2016-2017 4 5 school year. Whitney was informed by letter on March 10, 2016, that 6 Whitney's contract was renewed and that signing the contract and/or 7 reporting for work under the contract was considered acceptance of the 8 contract. PPSD payroll records indicate Whitney did report for work under 9 the new contract. On November 18, 2016, Whitney submitted her resignation to be effective December 1, 2016. Whitney was advised of the 10 11 requirement to provide 60 days' notice as detailed in state law. PPSD 12 informed Whitney that they would be holding her to the required 60 day 13 resignation notice required by law. Whitney informed PPSD that she had sought and received other employment that required her to begin work 14 immediately, and Whitney was unable or refused to provide the requested 15 16 60 day notice.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Heather Whitney's unprofessional conduct, as described above, constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (*Use professional judgment*), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (*Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations*); and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(j) (*Resignation from a contract in violation of ORS 342.553*).
