1 BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 2 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the) STIPULATION OF FACTS AND 4 **Educator License of**) FINAL ORDER OF 5 CATHERINE MAUREEN BAGLIEN) PUBLIC REPRIMAND 6 7 8 On November 9, 2015, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 9 (Commission) received a report from the North Clackamas School District (NCSD), 10 advising that Catherine Baglien (Baglien) may have violated professional standards. 11 After review of the matters alleged, Baglien and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to 12 13 certain facts and the imposition of a public reprimand. 14 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the 15 sanction to be imposed. Baglien stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the 16 Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set 17 forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Baglien waives the right to a hearing to 18 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below. 19 By signing below, Baglien acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to 20 the following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a hearing to 21 contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and 22 finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Public Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); 23 24 (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public 25 upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent 26 upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does 27 not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Baglien nor the 28 Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this Stipulation and 29 Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, without any force or 30 duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of 31 the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promise or representation has 32 been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) she has 33 consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully

advised with regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an

1 attorney prior to entering into this Stipulation and Final Order and issuance and entry of 2 the Stipulated Final Order below. 3 STIPULATION OF FACTS 4 1. The Commission has licensed Baglien since August 11, 1987. Baglien holds a 5 Legacy Teaching License, with endorsements in Elementary - Multiple Subjects (PK-12); Special Education - General (PK-12); Specialization: Early Childhood 6 7 (PK-12); and Social Studies (PK-12), is valid from November 8, 2017 through 8 November 7, 2020. During all relevant times, Baglien was employed by the North 9 Clackamas School District (NCSD). 10 11 2. On November 9, 2015, the Commission received a district report alleging Baglien 12 had violated professional standards and local policy related to unnecessary 13 physical force with a student. Investigation determined the following: 14 15 The District determined that on or about January 22, 2016, Baglien 16 removed a special education student's hand from a staff member's 17 hand/wrist in a manner inconsistent with Oregon Intervention System 18 (OIS) training and district policy on student intervention, physical force, 19 and restraints. In February 2016, the district issued Baglien a letter of 20 reprimand related to her conduct. 21 The District determined that during May and June 2016, Baglien pulled a 22 special education student by the wrist to direct him or redirect him and 23 spoke inappropriately with that student in a manner inconsistent with 24 district and OIS principles and training. On September 9, 2016, the 25 district issued Baglien a letter of reprimand and a one day suspension 26 without pay for her conduct. 27 28 29 IT IS SO STIPULATED: 7-5-18 Date 4/6/2018 30 31 32 33 34 Trent Danowski, Deputy Director 35 Teacher Standards and Practices Commission

1	CONCLUSION OF LAW
2	The conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS
3	342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(1)
4	(Recognize the worth and dignity of all persons and respect for each individual), OAR
5	584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0020(2)(d) (Skill in the
6	supervision of students), and OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and
7	reasonable rules and regulations).
8	
9	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
10	ORS 342.175.
11	ORDER
12	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
13	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a public reprimand on Angela M.
14	Baglien' Oregon educator licenses.
15	Furthermore, the Commission required Baglien complete and submit proof of
16	approved OIS training. On March 15, 2018, Baglien provided the Commission proof of
17	completion of OIS training that satisfies this requirement
