



1 4. During the 2004-2005 school year, Mr. Fischer used a district computer to access  
2 thousands of sexually explicit Internet sites in violation of the District's Internet use policy.

3 5. Beginning in 1997, Mr. Fischer repeatedly failed to maintain professional student-teacher  
4 relationships with a number of female students who attended Centennial High School. Mr. Fischer  
5 sent them unprofessional notes, contacted the female students at their homes and work places, and  
6 gave them gifts.

7 6. On January 27, 2005, the Gresham Police Department contacted US Customs, Homeland  
8 Security and reported that Centennial School District found that a teacher had accessed Internet  
9 websites from the school computer containing child pornography.

10 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

11  
12 Brett David Fischer's inappropriate use of District computer equipment violated OAR 584-020-  
13 0040(4)(a) and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(q). Mr. Fischer's inappropriate contact with students  
14 constitutes Gross Neglect of duty in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(4)(f) and OAR 584-020-  
15 0040(4)(o), as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0035(1)(c). This misconduct constitutes Gross Neglect of  
16 Duty. The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

17 **ORDER**

18 The Commission hereby revokes the Standard Teaching License issued to Brett David  
19 Fischer.
