7 her son, a student at Ontario High School.

8 4. Ms. Echanis accepts responsibility for her misconduct in this matter.

18 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

19 Mary Margaret Echanis violated OAR 584-020-0040(4)(o) by using her position  
20 as a teacher to access student CIM files to create a forged CIM report for her son, a  
21 student at Ontario High School. This misconduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty.  
22 The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS  
23 342.175(1)(b).



1 **ORDER**


2 The Commission revokes the Oregon Teaching License of Mary Margaret
