9	4. On May 6, 2004, Mr. Ward entered Serenity Lane residential treatment program and
10	successfully completed the residential treatment on May 28, 2004.
11	5. Mr. Ward transitioned into Serenity Lane's Intensive Outpatient Program and
12	completed the treatment on August 26, 2004.

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
