| 14 | | for unlawful sex with a minor, who was his student at the time, and (2) the |
| 15 | | failure to acknowledge disciplinary action taken by CTCC that resulted in the |
| 16 | | revocation of his California Teaching Credentials. |
| 17 | 2. | Mr. Johnson also knowingly altered the expiration date of his revoked |
| 18 | | California Teaching Credential when he submitted it to TSPC as a basis for |
| 19 | | obtaining his Oregon Teaching License. |
| 20 | | CONCLUSIONS OF LAW |
| 21 | 1. | Mr. Johnson violated OAR 584-20-040(4)(c) when he submitted an application |

| 11 | unearned grade. Mr. Johnson's apparent violation of his probation, committed when | | |
| 12 | he applied for his Oregon Teaching License, is additional evidence that he is neither a | | |
| 13 | competent or ethical educator as those terms are used in the TSPC rules. Notification | | |
| 14 | to the proper authorities of this possible parole violation is strongly recommended. | | |
