3	February 20, 2002, valid though February 20, 2005, with a Substitute Any Specialty
4	Endorsement. Mr. Ashbeck also holds a Transitional Teaching License Restricted to
5	Umatilla-Morrow ESD, issued September 13, 2002, valid through February 20, 2005,
6	with Basic Mathematics and Integrated Science Endorsements.
7	2. Mr. Ashbeck served as a substitute teacher for Hermiston School District for
8	the 2003-2004 school year.
9	3. A District-owned computer with Internet access was present in Mr. Ashbeck's
10	classroom for his use in connection with his assigned responsibilities. The District has
11	an acceptable use policy. The District's policy prohibits the use or attempted use of
12	equipment for Internet access of offensive materials or pictures.
13	4. Mr. Ashbeck used his classroom computer to access offensive messages and
14	pictures through the District's Internet connection in violation of District policy regarding
15	Internet use.

5	the workplace using a District owned computer was inappropriate and in violation of
6	District policy.
7	CONCLUSION OF LAW
8	James Frank Ashbeck's inappropriate use of a District computer constitutes
9	Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(4)(b) and OAR 584-020-
10	0040(4)(q). The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based
11	upon ORS 342.175.

ORDER

2	James Frank Ashbeck's Restricted Transitional Teaching License and Restricted
3	Substitute License are suspended for a period of ninety (90) days effective on July 1,
4	2004. At the end of this suspension period, the Commission will issue a teaching
5	license to Mr. Ashbeck upon:
6	1. Submission of evidence that he has completed a teacher education program;
7	2. Submission of a complete application and fees pursuant to OAR 584-050-
8	0015(3); and
9	3. Submission of documentation that he has undergone an evaluation by a
10	psychotherapist or medical professional acceptable to the Commission, and the
11	evaluator submits a written report to the Commission attesting (a) Mr. Ashbeck is fit to
2	work with children and teenagers, and (b) there is a high probability he will not use
13	school district equipment to access sexually explicit materials or engage in similar
14	inappropriate behavior. Any costs associated with the assessment or treatment will be

Upon the reinstatement of licensure, Mr. Ashbeck shall be placed on probation by the Commission for a period of two (2) years, subject to the following conditions:

1. Mr. Ashbeck shall substantially comply with any treatment or counseling as recommended by the individual who completed the evaluation described above. Mr. Ashbeck shall authorize and sign any consent forms as necessary for the treatment provider or counselor to furnish records to or discuss Mr. Ashbeck's treatment with the Commission.

1	Mr. Ashbeck shall comply with all Standards for Competent and Ethical
2	Performance of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules, Chapter 584,
3	Division 020.
4	3. Mr. Ashbeck shall provide information as requested by the Commission to
5	verify that he has complied with the conditions of probation, including a statement from
6	a future employing district that he has complied with the Standards for Competent and
7	Ethical Performance of Oregon Educators.
8	Violation of the terms of this probation may constitute an independent basis for
9	the Commission to impose discipline, up to and including revocation of Mr. Ashbeck's
10	teaching license subject to Mr. Ashbeck's right to a hearing on the issue of whether he
11	violated probation.
