8	On August 17, 2017, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission
9	(Commission) received a report from the Molalla River School District, advising that
10	Jodi D. Stith (Stith) may have violated professional standards.
11	After review of the matters alleged, Stith and the Commission agree that their
12	respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to
13	certain facts and the imposition of a public reprimand.
14	This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the
15	sanction to be imposed. Stith stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the
16	Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set
17	forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Stith waives the right to a hearing to
18	contest the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order set forth below.
19	By signing below, Stith acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the
20	following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a hearing to contest
21	the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally
22	waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of
23	Facts and Final Order of Public Reprimand (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this
24	Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to the public upon
25	request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon and
26	subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not
27	approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Stith nor the
28	Commission are bound by the terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this Stipulation and
29	Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) she voluntarily, without any force or
30	duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of
31	the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promise or representation has
32	been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) she has
33	consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully

advised with regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an

1. The Commission has licensed Stith since July 3, 2007. Stith holds a Preliminary Teaching License, with endorsements in Elementary – Multiple Subjects (PK-12) and English to Speakers of Other Languages (PK-12), valid from August 2, 2016, through April 18, 2020. During all relevant times, Stith was employed by the Molalla River School District.

2. On August 17, 2017, the Commission received information from the Molalla River School district (MRSD) indicating Stith may have committed acts which constitute gross neglect of duty. MRSD reported that on or about December 12, 2016, Stith had reported to work while still sick and under the influence of medications that affected Stith's ability to perform her duties.

Investigation determined that on December 12, 2016, school officials were notified by staff that Stith appeared unconscious in her classroom with students present. Co-workers experienced difficulty in rousing Stith awake. Stith's students were escorted out of the classroom and Stith's family was called to pick her up. It was later learned that Stith had been suffering from an illness and was likely dehydrated. Stith had taken her regularly prescribed medications and had taken an over- the- counter cold medication in an attempt to work that day because the school was having a holiday presentation that Stith did not want to miss sharing with her students. As a result, Stith was unable to properly perform her duties or supervise her classroom. The students in Stith's classroom reported they had tried but had been unable to wake Stith up. Stith received medical attention and was cleared to return to work several days later.

MRSD issued Stith a reprimand and five days off without pay for failure to be forthcoming about her medical condition on December 12, 2016, despite admittedly feeling disoriented throughout the day. There have been no other reports of similar incidents since the December 12, 2016 occurrence.

9	CONCLUSION OF LAW
10	The conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS
11	342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as
12	it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-
13	0020(2)(d) (Skill in the supervision of students); and OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using
14	district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations).
15	
16	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon
17	ORS 342.175.
18	ORDER
19	The Commission adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and
20	conclusions of law, and based thereon, imposes a public reprimand on Jodi D. Stith's
21	Oregon educator licenses.
