On July 18, 2001, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) issued 7 a notice of opportunity for hearing to David Andrew Clair. Mr. Clair requested a hearing to 8 contest the allegations in the notice, and a hearing was scheduled for February 25, 2002. 9

Mr. Clair and the Commission have now reviewed the matters alleged and have agreed that their respective interests, together with the public interest, would be served by entry of a stipulation and order of suspension of Mr. Clair's teaching license, followed by a period of probation. Mr. Clair does not admit that he engaged in wrongdoing or violated any standards of professional conduct. However, Mr. Clair stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in 14 the files and records of the Commission to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set 15 forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Mr. Clair consents to the Commission making these 16 findings and conclusions, and he understands that the Commission will enter an order suspending 17 his teaching license. 18

This stipulation and order is subject to approval by the Commission at its next scheduled 19 meeting. If the Commission does not adopt this stipulation and order, neither Mr. Clair nor the 20 Commission shall be bound by any matters contained herein, and Mr. Clair shall retain his rights 21 to a hearing on the allegations in the notice. 22

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Mr. Clair holds a Standard Oregon Teaching License. He has been employed as a 9 1. middle-school teacher with the Central Point School District since September 10 1976. 11
- On May 5, 2000, the school district placed Mr. Clair on administrative leave. On 2. 12 about October 2000, the district reassigned Mr. Clair to a position at the technical 13 center at the high school. In January 2002, Mr. Clair and the district entered into 14 an agreement in which Mr. Clair agreed to continue in a non-certified position at 15 the technical center of the high school. 16
- On several occasions in 1999 and in 2000, Mr. Clair addressed middle-school 3. 17 female students in an overly familiar and overly personal manner. This conduct 18 caused the students to be uncomfortable and created an intimidating, hostile or 19 offensive educational environment. 20
- On various occasions in 1999 and 2000, Mr. Clair touched the shoulders, face or 21 4. hands of female middle-school students in a manner that was offensive to the 22
