- administration of an Oregon Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (OAKS) science test.
 - 3. Investigation determined that between December 18, 2014, and February 9, 2015, Poll was provided materials and training related to the proper administration of the OAKS Science test. On January 26, 2015, Poll signed the Test Administrator Assurance of Test Security form. On February 9, 2015, after the students had completed the OAKS testing Poll administered, Poll conducted a lesson with tested students titled "OAKS Debrief Activity". Sections of Poll's worksheet required students to write down test items they remembered from the OAKS test. collaborate with peers about test questions, and inform Poll of test questions or topics students had questions about. Poll conducted this follow up lesson with the intent to re-teach the test items prior to any subsequent testing attempts. The Oregon Department of Education reviewed the school district's report of a possible testing impropriety and concluded that Poll's debriefing activities were testing improprieties that violated the requirements of the testing administration manual which prohibits any review or discussion of test content for any reason. Because Poll's debriefing activities occurred after the students had completed the testing, the student's test results were not invalidated. As a result of Poll's conduct, the school district issued Poll a reprimand to include a one day, unpaid suspension.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Robert Frank Poll's conduct, as described above, constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty in violation of ORS 342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional judgment), OAR 584-020-0015(2)(e) (Skill in the selection and use of teaching techniques conducive to student learning), and OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations).
