7	Based on negotiations between the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission
8	(Commission) and Karen Diane Hutchinson Talaski, the parties have agreed to enter into a
9	stipulation of facts, a voluntary surrender of Ms. Hutchinson Talaski's Oregon Teaching License
10	and certain conditions set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Ms. Hutchinson Talaski
11	waives her right to a hearing and understands that the Commission will accept the surrender of
12	her license and will revoke the teaching license.
13	
14	STIPULATED FACTS
15	1. Ms. Hutchinson Talaski holds a basic Oregon Teaching License with an
16	endorsement in elementary education.
17	2. Hutchinson Talaski was employed as a teacher with the Morrow County School
18	District from August 1992 until October 1998 when she resigned her position.
19	3. During a period between September 1994 and August 1995, Ms. Hutchinson
20	Talaski served in the capacity of secretary of the Morrow County Education Association. During
21	that time frame, Ms. Hutchinson Talaski embezzled approximately \$9,000.00 from funds
22	belonging to the Morrow County Education Association.
23	4. As a result of the above, Ms. Hutchinson Talaski was indicted by the Morrow
24	County Grand Jury on December 14, 1998, and charged with multiple counts of theft.

1	5. On March 18, 1999, Ms. Hutchinson Talaski entered a plea of guilty to the crime
2	of Theft in the First Degree and was sentenced by the Morrow County Circuit Court to pay a fine
3	of \$500.00, suspended, to serve a suspended jail sentence, to pay restitution in the amount of
4	\$9,000.00 to the Morrow County Education Association and to be placed on formal probation
5	with the Oregon Department of Corrections for a period of two years.
6	6. One of the conditions of probation is that Ms. Hutchinson Talaski cooperate with
7	the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission regarding two years revocation of her teaching
8	license. Ms. Hutchinson Talaski agrees to surrender her Oregon Teaching License and to waive
9	her right to apply for reinstatement of her teaching license for a period of two years from the date
10	of her conviction in March 1999.

24	The above conduct constitutes gross unfitness in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(5)(c).

## 1 **DISCUSSION** 2 Ms. Hutchinson Talaski's criminal behavior was directly related to her responsibilities as 3 an educator and the trust afforded to her by her colleagues, her school and community. 4 If in the future Ms. Hutchinson Talaski applies for reinstatement of her teaching license, 5 the decision would lie within the discretion of the commissioners who consider the matter at that time. Without limiting the discretion of future commissioners, it would be expected that 6 7 Ms. Hutchinson Talaski demonstrate, at a minimum, that she has complied with all conditions of 8 court ordered probation, that she has not violated any professional standards under OAR 584 9 Division 20, and that she has shown evidence of having successfully completed counseling 10 and/or mental health treatment related to her unprofessional conduct. 11 12 **ORDER** The Commission accepts the voluntary surrender of the Oregon Teaching License of 13 Karen Diane Hutchinson Talaski, and the Commission revokes the license pursuant to OAR 584-14 15 050-0027. 16 DATED this /g day of May 1999. 17 18 TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 19 20 21 By: David V.
