

9 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

10 1. Mr. Reed holds an Oregon Basic Teaching License, valid from April 28, 2004,
11 through July 5, 2007, with endorsements in Basic Physics, Standard Chemistry and Standard
12 Social Studies. He has held an Oregon Teaching License since September 1995.

13 2. Mr. Reed was employed by the Central Linn School District during the 2003-4
14 school year as the dean of students and as a coach.

15 3. On about May 5, 2004, while serving as a middle school track coach, Mr. Reed
16 licked the blood from a wound on the knee of LE, a female middle school student.

17 4. During the 2003 football season, Mr. Reed licked blood from the arm of KL, a
18 male student in the school locker room before a football practice.

19 5. During the 2003 football season, Mr. Reed licked blood from the hand of CH, a
20 male high school student.

21 6. Mr. Reed's actions were in violation of the school district's policies concerning
22 precautions in dealing with blood-borne pathogens.

2 **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

3 Scott Lloyd Reed's action in licking the blood of students constitutes gross neglect of
4 duty in violation of OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as that rule incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5)
5 and 584-020-0025(2)(e).

6 **ORDER**

7 The Commission imposes a public reprimand upon Scott Lloyd Reed, and this order shall
8 serve as the public reprimand.

9 Mr. Reed shall be placed on probation with the Commission for a period of two years
10 from the date of this order. Conditions of probation shall include the following:

11 1. Within the next 60 days, Mr. Reed shall attend a class concerning safety and
12 avoiding risk of exposure to blood-borne pathogens. Mr. Reed shall furnish to the Commission
13 written verification of his attendance.

14 2. Mr. Reed shall not lick blood on the person of any student or co-worker.

15 3. Mr. Reed shall comply with all Standards of Competent and Ethical Performance
16 of Educators under OAR 584 Division 020.

17 Failure to comply with any condition of probation shall be a basis in itself for discipline,
18 up to and including revocation of Mr. Reed's teaching license, subject to Mr. Reed's right to a
19 hearing on the issue of whether he violated probation.
