CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

2 Mr. Smith's conviction for Disseminate Obscene Material, ORS 167.087 is listed in ORS
3 342.143(3). The Commission is required to revoke the Standard Teaching License issued to
4 Mr. Smith and revoke his right to apply for a license pursuant to ORS 342.175(2). The Commission's
5 authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.

ORDER

7 The Commission hereby revokes the Standard Teaching License issued to Christopher
8 Frederick Smith and revokes his right to apply for a teaching license.
