BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION 1 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 2 3 In the Matter of the 4 DEFAULT ORDER 5 Teaching License of REVOKING RIGHT TO 6 ANDREW JAY LOCKWOOD REINSTATE LICENSE 7 8 On or about December 8, 1998, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission received a 9 judgment and sentencing report from Multnomah County Circuit Court, indicating that Andrew 10 Jay Lockwood had been convicted of three counts of Attempted Sex Abuse III on July 13, 1998. 11 On January 15, 1999, the Commission took action to charge Lockwood with violation of TSPC 12 Standards based on this conviction. The Executive Director notified Mr. Lockwood of intent to 13 revoke his right to reinstate his teaching license, and to inform Lockwood of his opportunity for 14 hearing. The notice, dated January 25, 1999, and signed by David V. Myton, Executive 15 Director, stated: 16 17 "You, Andrew Jay Lockwood, are entitled to a hearing on the proposed 18 revocation of your right to reinstate your Oregon Teaching License. If you desire 19 a hearing, you must notify the Executive Director of the Commission, in writing, 20 within 21 days of the date of this notice." 21 22 The notice of opportunity for hearing was sent by U.S. Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested 23 #P 412 422 614. The receipt was signed on January 28, 1999 and returned to TSPC. Mr. 24 Lockwood did not request a hearing. 25 26 FINDINGS OF FACT 27 28 Andrew Jay Lockwood held a Basic Teaching License with elementary endorsement 29 1. valid from June 7, 1995 to September 25, 1998. 30 31 On July 13, 1998, Andrew Jay Lockwood was convicted of three counts of Attempted 2. 32 Sex Abuse in the First Degree in Multnomah County Circuit Court. On December 3, 33 1998, Lockwood was sentenced to 32 months imprisonment; 60 months post-prison 34 supervision; and ordered to pay \$5,000 in restitution to victims. 35 36 The crimes involved male elementary students in the David Douglas School District. 37 3. 38 ULTIMATE FINDINGS OF FACT 39 40 On July 13, 1998, Andrew Jay Lockwood entered a plea of "guilty" and was convicted of three 41 counts of Attempted Sex Abuse in the First Degree in Multnomah County Circuit Court. 42 43 44 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW 45 46 Under ORS 342.175, the Commission may find a conviction for the above crimes to constitute 47

Gross Unfitness under Standards of Competent and Ethical Performance for Oregon Educator.
