On or about June 7, 2004, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) received a report from Jim Robinson, Superintendent, Lebanon Community Schools, indicating that the District had received complaints of sexual harassment and/or inappropriate interactions with female staff members regarding Frederick "Chip" Wafer (Wafer).

Mr. Wafer fully cooperated with the Commission's investigation. After review of the matters alleged, Mr. Wafer and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and the imposition of a 30 day suspension of licensure followed by a three (3) year period of probation upon reinstatement of licensure.

This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the sanction to be imposed. Mr. Wafer stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth below. In entering into this stipulation, Mr. Wafer waives the right to a hearing to contest the finding of fact, conclusion of law and order set forth below.

This stipulation is contingent upon approval and adoption of the Order by the Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this Order, neither Mr. Wafer nor the Commission are bound by these stipulations, and Mr. Wafer retains all rights to a hearing on the allegations.

STIPULATION OF FACTS

1. Mr. Wafer holds a Standard Teaching License issued June 2, 2003, valid through June 20, 2008, with an endorsement in Standard Advanced Mathematics. Mr. Wafer's Initial Administrator License expired on June 20, 2004. Mr. Wafer applied for renewal on June 8, 2004, said application is pending renewal.

1	2. Mr. Wafer was employed as an Assistant Principal at South Umpqua High School from		
	August 1, 2001, through July 1, 2003. On September 9, 2002, a female staff member complained tha		
3	Mr. Wafer repeatedly contacted her residence by telephone and visited her in an attempt to date her.		
4	She requested that he discontinue this behavior and requested that another administrator supervise		
5	and evaluate her performance.		
6	3. Mr. Wafer was employed as a Assistant Principal for Lebanon High School beginning		
7	August 19, 2003. Mr. Wafer resigned his employment effective July 1, 2004.		
8	4. During the 2003-2004 school year, Mr. Wafer subjected subordinate female staff members		
9	and a contracted service employee to inappropriate comments concerning sexually related topics,		
10	jokes, or innuendo, which caused a pattern that eventually resulted in concerns and complaints of		
11	harassment.		
12	5. Mr. Wafer admits that he subjected female staff members to inappropriate comments		
13	involving sexual topics or innuendo while performing his duties as Assistant Principal for Lebanon		
	High School.

22	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW		
23	Mr. Wafer's repeated and unwanted behavior toward female employees whom he supervised		
24	at Lebanon High School violated OAR 584-020-0040(4)(I), by creating an intimidating, hostile and		
25	offensive working environment. Mr. Wafer failed to demonstrate a commitment to use professional		
26	judgment when he attempted to date a teacher whom he supervised at South Umpqua High School is		
27	violation of OAR 584-020-0010(5). This conduct constitutes Gross Neglect of Duty. The		
	Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.		

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1 ORDER

The Commission adopts the foregoing Stipulation of Facts and suspends the licensure of Frederick Albert Wafer II, for a period of 30 days effective on April 28, 2005. At the end of this suspension period, Mr. Wafer's licensure will be reinstated upon:

- 1. Submission of complete applications and fees pursuant to OAR 584-050-0015(3);
- 2. Submission of documentation that he has completed (at his own expense), a college level course on sexual harassment in the work place conducted by a qualified trainer approved in advance by the Commission.
- 3. Submission of documentation that he has completed (at his own expense) intensive counseling and boundaries training to modify his behavior. This intensive training shall consist of, at least eight (8) contact hours. Mr. Wafer shall provide the trainer with a copy of this Order and any additional documentation as required by the trainer. The program trainer shall provide the Commission with a report of successful program completion together with an evaluation report to the Commission verifying that Mr. Wafer's suitability to resume serving as a licensed educator.

Upon the reinstatement of licensure, Mr. Wafer shall be placed on probation by the Commission for a period of three (3) years, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Mr. Wafer shall substantially comply with any subsequent treatment or counseling as recommended by the individual who completed the training and evaluation described above.

 Mr. Wafer shall authorize and sign any consent forms as necessary for the treatment provider to furnish records to or discuss Mr. Wafer's treatment with the Commission.
- 2. Mr. Wafer shall comply with all Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance of Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules, Chapter 584, Division 020.
- 3. Mr. Wafer shall provide information as requested by the Commission to verify that he has complied with the conditions of probation, including a statement from a future employing district that he has complied with the Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance of Oregon Educators by April 28, 2006.

1	Violation of any term or condition of this probation may constitute an independent basis for the		
	Commission to impose discipline, up to and including revocation of Mr. Wafer's teaching and/or		
3	administrative license subject to Mr. Wafer's right to a hearing on the issue of whether he violated		
4	probation.
