Ms. Page fully cooperated with the Commission's investigation. After a review of the matters 9 alleged, Ms. Page and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public 10 interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts and a public reprimand. 11 This document sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the stipulated 12 sanction to be imposed. Ms. Page stipulates that there is sufficient evidence in the Commission's files 13 and records to support the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below. 14 By signing below, Ms. Page acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the 15 following: (i) she has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of 16 fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any 17 rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Reprimand 18 (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and disclosed to 19 the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is contingent upon 20 and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and 21 adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Ms. Page nor the Commission are bound by the 22 terms herein; (iv) she has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; 23 (v) she voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and 24 consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) she states that no promises or 25 representation has been made to induce her to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) she has

consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised with

regard to her rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to entering

1 FINAL ORDER The Commission hereby adopts and incorporates herein the above findings of fact and 2 conclusions of law and hereby imposes a Public Reprimand on Lisa Marie Page. This Order shall 3 4 serve as the Public Reprimand. Furthermore, the Commission places Ms. Page on Probation for a period of four (4) years 5 subject to the following terms and conditions: 6 1. Ms. Page shall, at her own initiative and expense, continue to obtain treatment for her 7 alcohol dependency as recommended by her alcohol treatment provider and abstain from the 8 9 consumption of alcohol; 2. During the period of this probation, Ms. Page shall submit to the Executive Director of the 10 Commission reports of her compliance with her treatment plan. Ms. Page shall provide these reports 11 12 every six (6) months during her probation, beginning August 8, 2008; 3. Ms. Page shall report in writing within ten days to the Executive Director of the Commission 13 any arrest or citation for any felony, misdemeanor, major traffic violation or violation of criminal 14 15 probation; and 4. Ms. Page shall comply with the Standards for Competent and Ethical Performance of 16 Oregon Educators under Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 584, Division 020. 17 Violation of any term or condition of probation shall constitute an independent basis for the 18 Commission to revoke Ms. Page's teaching license or otherwise impose discipline, after first providing 19 20 Ms. Page with notice and opportunity for hearing.
