6	On or about September 24, 1998, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (the				
7	"Commission") issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to Jon Alvin Beisenherz (Beisenherz)				
8	in which the Commission proposed to suspend or revoke his teaching license or otherwise				
9	impose discipline under ORS342.177 based upon misrepresentations on his TSPC application				
10	form and inappropriate contact with a student. The Commission and Beisenherz have now				
11	reviewed the matters alleged and agree that their respective interests, together with the public				
12	interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, a public reprimand of Beisenherz and the				
13	imposition of a two-year probation. This agreement sets for the facts upon which the parties				
14	have agreed and the sanctions to be imposed. In entering into this Stipulation, Beisenherz				
15	waives his right to a hearing to contest any of the findings set forth below or to contest the				
16	Commission's Order of Suspension and Probation.

18	FINDINGS OF FACT				
19	1. Beisenherz was employed as the Principal of North Lake High School in Silver Lake from September, 1994 through June, 1998. On November 17, 1997, he resigned that				
20	position in lieu of termination for alleged misconduct in the form of inappropriate, no sexual touching of a female student effective in June, 1998.				
21	On October 4, 1995, Beisenherz received a directive from the Superintendent of North Lake School District, Mr. Jim Chapman, to not touch students unless it was to stop a

10	this Order, neither Beisenherz nor the Commission are bound by these Stipulations and				
11	Beisenherz retains all rights to a hearing on the allegations.
