BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the STIPULATION OF FACTS) 4 Teaching License of AND) 5 Ronald Ray Baker ORDER OF REPRIMAND 6 7 On or about November 15, 2004, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission 8 (Commission) received a report from Darce Driskel, Deputy Superintendent, Hermiston School 9 District, indicating that Ronald Ray Baker (Baker) will be arraigned in Federal court for 10 bankruptcy fraud and cattle theft. 11 After review of the matters alleged, Mr. Baker and the Executive Director agree that their 12 respective interests, together with the public interests, are best served by a stipulation to certain 13 facts and a reprimand. 14 This Order sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and to the sanction to be imposed. Mr. Baker stipulates that there are sufficient facts contained in the Commission's 16 files and records to support the findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth below. In 17 entering into this stipulation, Mr. Baker waives the right to a hearing to contest the findings of 18 fact, conclusion of law and order set forth below. 19 The stipulation is contingent upon approval and adoption of the Order by the 20 Commission. If the Commission does not adopt this Order, neither Mr. Baker nor the 21 Commission are bound by these stipulations and Mr. Baker retains all rights to a hearing on the 22 allegations.
