## BEFORE THE TEACHER STANDARDS AND PRACTICES COMMISSION CEIVED 1 2 JAN 22 2019 OF THE STATE OF OREGON 3 In the Matter of the STIPULATION OF FACTS AND Teacher Standards & Educator License of FINAL ORDER OF SUSPENSION Practices Commission ) BARON M. GUIDO 6 On September 22, 2017, the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (Commission) 7 received a report from the Brookings-Harbor School District alleging that Baron Guido (Guido) had 8 violated Professional Standards and Practices. 9 After review of the matters alleged, Guido and the Commission agree that their respective interests, together with the public interest, are best served by a stipulation to certain facts, and the 10 11 imposition of a thirty (30) day suspension of Guido's Oregon educator license. 12 This document sets forth the facts upon which the parties have agreed and the stipulated 13 sanction to be imposed. Guido stipulates that there is sufficient evidence in the Commission's files and records to support the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order set forth below. 14 15 By signing below, Guido acknowledges, understands, stipulates, and agrees to the following: 16 (i) he has been fully advised of his rights to notice and a hearing to contest the findings of fact, 17 conclusions of law, and order set forth below, and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights 18 to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulation of Facts and Final Order of Suspension and Probation (Stipulation and Final Order); (ii) this Stipulation and Final Order is a public document and 19 disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulation and Final Order is 20 21 contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the Commission does not approve and adopt this Stipulation and Final Order, then neither Guido nor the Commission are 22 bound by the terms herein; (iv) he has fully read this Stipulation and Final Order, and understands it completely; (v) he voluntarily, without any force or duress, enters into this Stipulation and Final Order and consents to issuance and entry of the Stipulated Final Order below; (vi) he states that no promises or representation has been made to induce him to sign this Stipulation and Final Order; and (vii) he has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulation and Final Order and has been fully advised

with regard to his rights thereto, or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to

## STIPULATION OF FACTS

- 1) Guido has been licensed as an Educator in Oregon since August 16, 2005. Guido holds 5 Professional Teaching License, with an endorsement in Special Education: Generalist (PK-12), valid from April 21, 2017 through September 4, 2022. Guido also holds a Continuing 6 7 Administrator License, with an endorsement in Administrator (ALL LVL), valid from October 8, 2015, through September 4, 2021. During all relevant times, Guido was employed by the 8 9 Brookings-Harbor School District.
- 2) On September 22, 2017, the Commission received information from the Brookings-Harbor School 10 11 District indicating Guido may have committed acts which constitute gross neglect of duty. The district reported that on or about June 20, 2017, Guido had reported to work (on school grounds) 12 13 under the influence of alcohol.
  - 3) Investigation determined that on June 20, 2017, school officials were notified by staff that Guido smelled of alcohol at the work place. District officials, believing Guido was under the influence of intoxicants, escorted Guido to be tested for intoxicants. Guido voluntarily submitted to a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) breath testing. At 11:44 AM, Guido was tested and had a BAC of .049. At 11:54 AM, Guido was tested again and had a BAC of .030. Guido was placed on administrative leave pending completion of the local investigation. Both test results indicated Guido was under the influence of alcohol. Guido and his medical provider asserted that during this time he was taking the prescription drug Naltrexone as part of his treatment. Guido asserts that a possible side effect of Naltrexone is the drug delays the metabolizing of any alcohol ingested (reducing a person's need to continue to consume alcohol). If valid, a person who consumes alcohol while taking Naltrexone would retain the alcohol in their system longer than someone without Naltrexone, but would remain under the influence as indicated by the testing results. On July 13, 2017, Guido resigned his employment with the district.

9	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
10	Baron M. Guido's conduct described above constitutes gross neglect of duty in violation of ORS
11	342.175(1)(b); OAR 584-020-0040(4)(n) as it incorporates OAR 584-020-0010(5) (Use professional
12	judgment), OAR 584-020-0025(2)(e) (Using district lawful and reasonable rules and regulations);
13	and OAR 584-020-0040(4)(g) (Appearing on duty or at any district-sponsored activity while under
14	the influence of alcohol or any controlled substance).
15 16	The Commission's authority to impose discipline in this matter is based upon ORS 342.175.
17	ORDER
18	The Commission hereby adopts and incorporates herein the above stipulation of facts,
19	conclusions of law, and based thereon hereby imposes a thirty (30) day suspension of Guido's Oregon
20	educator licenses following the adoption of this order.
