19	document and disclosed to the public upon request by the Commission; (iii) this Stipulated Final
20	Order is contingent upon and subject to approval and adoption by the Commission. If the

2	1. Mr. Jackson applied for a Charter School Administrator Registration on
3	December 10, 2007. Mr. Jackson has been licensed as an attorney in Oregon since 1976.
4	2. In 1986, Mr. Jackson was admonished by the Oregon State Bar for neglect of a
5	legal matter and failure to cooperate with disciplinary counsel. Mr. Jackson did not disclose or
8	provide a detailed explanation of this discipline in his application to the Commission.
7	3. In 1996, Mr. Jackson was reprimended by the Oregon State Bar for neglect of a
8	legal matter. Mr. Jackson did not disclose or provide a detailed explanation of this discipline in
9	his application to the Commission.
10	4. In 1999, Mr. Jackson was suspended from the practice of law for 30 days for
11	failing to maintain client records and failing to account for client funds.
12	5. In 2008, Mr. Jackson was suspended from the practice of Law for 180 days for
13	neglect of a legal matter, making a misrepresentation to a tribunal, conduct prejudicial to the
14	administration of justice, and engaging in conduct involving misrepresentation. Mr. Jackson ha
15	appealed the matter to the Oregon Supreme Court.
16	6. During the 2006-2007 school year, Mr. Jackson claimed that unregistered
17	persons teaching at Sand Ridge Charter School were not required to be registered with the
18	Commission,
